



# Responsibility for associations

Goal	Action
More efficient recycling, and as little mixed waste as possible	Enhance the recycling opportunities e.g. in guild rooms. Get recycling bins for different waste types e.g. plastic, biowaste etc. Communicate to members about the importance of recycling and be a good example to others.
Minimizing unnecessary items and materials	Avoid unnecessary purchases e.g. for the guild room. For annual ball gifts, consider giving an immaterial gift, and give material gifts only for the right need.
Reuse of materials and items	Necessary items for the guild rooms are purchased recycled as much as possible. For example, online flea markets and various Facebook pages (e.g. Loas Laakso) are effective places to find necessary items. Also give and sell items that are useless to the guild and pass them on.
Give up on single use cutlery and garbage bag tablecloths	Consider using durable dishes for events. Consider now using garbage bags as tablecloths e.g. on sitz. Instead, leave the tables as they are and clean them afterwards.
Environmental and responsibility themes as part of all decision-making	The association/guild can name a person in charge of sustainability, who makes sure of e.g. recycling opportunities and sustainable events. If need, a sustainability committee can be named under LTKY, where ideas and thoughts about sustainability can be discussed.
More sustainable policies part of associations actions Vastuullisempia linjauksia osaksi järjestöjen toimintaa	Policies can be decided e.g. on an annual general meeting about using plant based or local groceries, among other things.
